

DAC AGM RULE CHANGE SURPRISE

Dial-a-Cab's AGM, held in the sedate rooms of The Brewery in Chiswell Street on Sunday 10 February, was a meeting described by DaC Chairman Brian Rice as "...the most attentive, civilised and respectful membership of all the meetings I have been Chairman at." He added: "It was so nice to have drivers get up and ask sensible questions without setting out to try and catch anyone."



In a non-election year, the only surprise was the adoption of a rule change which now means that should Dial-a-Cab ever be sold and drivers receive remuneration for their one share each, that pay-out would now apply to every member who had been with the Society for two years or over. Previously, any driver joining after 1 September 2004 would not have qualified. The rule change amendment squeezed in with 53% voting in favour. Brian added that there were no current offers to buy DaC.
