Last year more than 1500 cabbies and their families got up close and personal to the diverse range of animals at ZSL London Zoo. Drivers will remember that at the time of this promotion, the Zoo also ran a promotion to see how many zoo keepers fit in the back of a cab! The Zoo hopes to build on the success of last year, encouraging even more cabbies to bring along the "pack", present their licences at the gate and enjoy the brilliant exhibits on display this summer.



Take a flight to the Zoo's newly opened Blackburn Pavilion - stroll through this tropical birdhouse, enjoying the sights and sounds of the forest sky. Visitors will be taken astonishingly close to the free-flying exotic birds including toucans and lovebirds. Swing in to the African rainforest habitat of the western lowland gorillas in the Gorilla Kingdom exhibit, and observe the beautiful brightly coloured butterflies flutter around the tropical oasis Butterfly Paradise.



Black cab drivers and their families can enjoy free entry to the Zoo from 9th - 12th of May inclusive.

Drivers will need to bring their cab license badges with them on the day and present them to staff waiting near the main gate to collect an entrance voucher. They can then proceed to the entrance booths and present the voucher to gate staff.

Family groups can be made up of two adults and two children or one adult and three children. Additional people will need to pay in full on the day.

NEW TAX LAWS SELF ASSESSMENT

We have now had 2 years of self assessment & the taxman not only has more time to examine self employed records but is getting better at his job with the help of computers.

Being both a driver and an accountant I know only too well what is required, and have constructed a very simple Daily Record Book.

This book should be started at the beginning of your financial year.

Stay in the taxman's good books by using the Robinsons Daily Record Book (£4.00 incl. p&p cheque to M. Robinson)

Journeyman Drivers

Would need to obtain receipts for cab rental and fuel and keep daily records of cash takings. Where the driver has a radio fitted he/she must produce radio statement sheets of account work and must NOT add these with cash takings. Any radio cash work should also be included in daily takings.

Owner Drivers

Would need to keep all repair bills, meter rentals, HP agreements, insurance costs, PCO licence fees, Derv bills, in fact anything to do with costs of Taxi.

Again if radio fitted, same as for Journeyman. Partners would need to keep separate daily takings etc.
